Dark Web Monitoring Overview

Why Dark Web Monitoring?

Dark Web Monitoring is an essential addition to every Managed Services offering, another addition to the state of security to monitor and protect your clients.

How does it Work?

1. All Breach Prevention Platform (BPP) clients receive Dark Web Monitoring for up to 3 domains
2. Dark Web Monitoring can be purchased as an add-on to the Partner Subscription in blocks of 10 domains.

Click the "+" next to a client to open the section where domains can be entered and to select or enter email address for notification of breaches.

For the domains entered for a client, this is the date of the last known breach for any of the domains.

The total number of breaches associated with the domains that have been entered for the client.


The discovery date is associated with the last DWM scan that identified a breach for any of the domains entered for a client.

Number of allocated DWM licenses for each Unlimited Training client (max of 3 per client). Domains for BPP clients are automatically added to the DWM watch list and do not count towards DWM licenses.

Dark Web Monitoring Step-by-Step Setup Guidelines

Purchasing Licenses:

Step 1: Login to the portal with your Partner Administrator account and click the “Dark Web Monitoring” link in the Action taskbar.



Dark Web Monitoring Step-by-Step Setup Guidelines

Allocating Licenses:

You can allocate licenses for existing Unlimited Training clients or you can add new Unlimited Training clients directly inside the Dark Web Monitoring dashboard.

Please note:

- Clients in **red** denote clients with no Dark Web Monitoring licenses allocated
- Breach Prevention Platform clients are by default black, as their domains are monitored as a feature to their subscription
- The “Display All Clients” button toggles between showing all clients, and only clients that have Dark Web Monitoring activated

Adding a New Client

Step 1: Click the “Add a New Client” button to add a new Unlimited Training client. A new row will be added to the table where you can then replace the ‘Enter client name here’ label with the Client Name.

Allocating Licenses:

Step 2: Clicking the “+” sign to the left of an Unlimited Training Client will allow you to manage your domain and notification settings for that client.

Please note:

- Once a domain is being monitored on an Unlimited Training client, this cannot be removed.
- Free up licenses by upgrading your Unlimited Training clients to the Breach Prevention Platform or send us a request to delete the client at operations@breachsecurenow.com
- Only employees setup in the portal will receive breach notifications

Allocating Licenses:

Step 3: Click the “+” to the right of “Add a New Domain” and enter up to 3 domains you would like to be monitored. Each domain utilizes a Dark Web Monitoring license.

Select who you want to receive an email alert in the event of a data breach.

- Your Organization – anyone listed as a user under your partner BPP account, a distribution list, or ticketing system
- Client Management – anyone listed as a manager under that client
- Employee – notification will be sent to the email address involved in the data breach
- Under “Additional Email Notification”, you can add email address that are not in the portal

Click “Confirm” once all the information has been entered and verified.

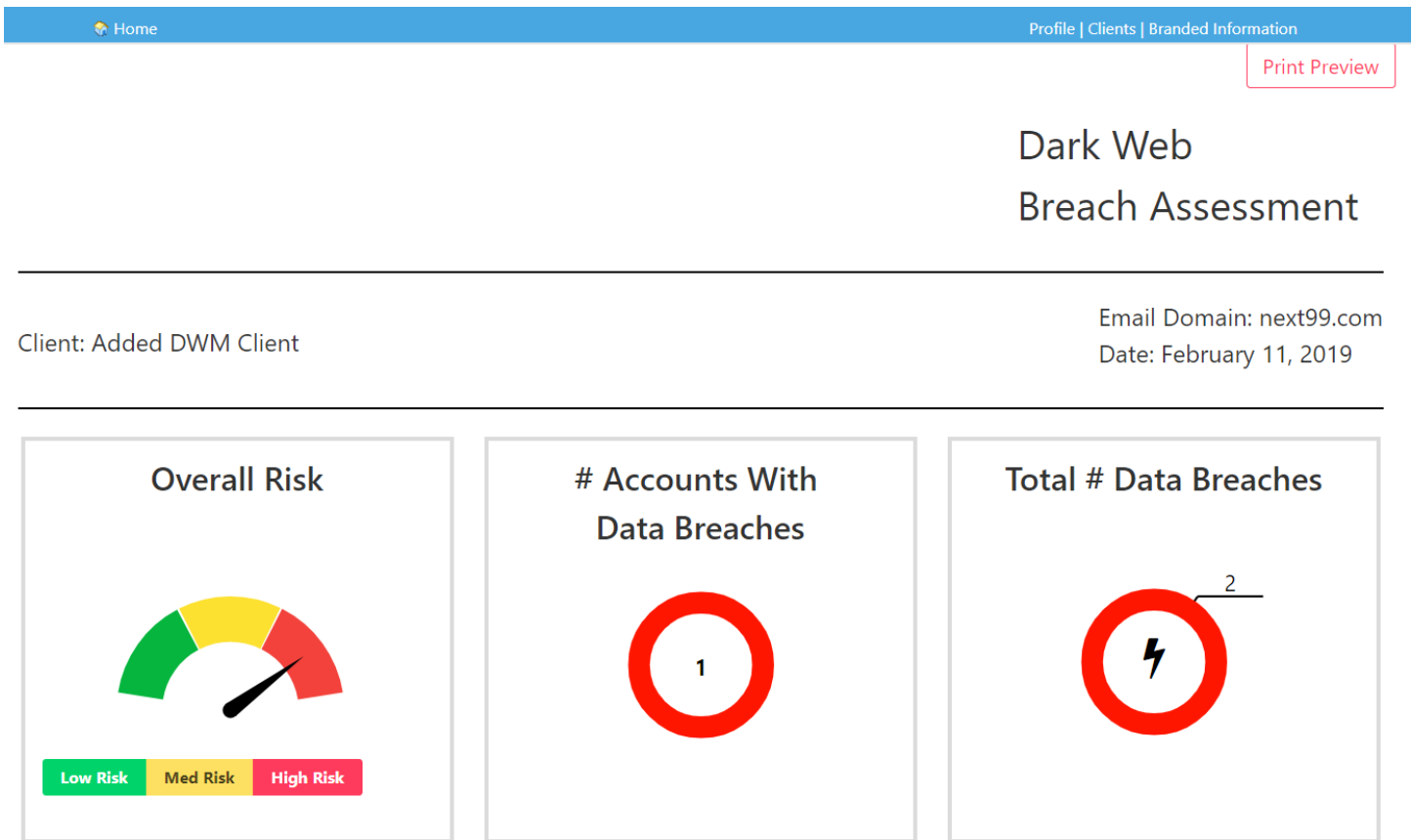
